## COMEDY SHOWS

Each comedy show has its own price (some of which are free) and tickets. Shows are typically an hour long, but are sometimes longer. See listings.



# 2 TYPES OF TICKET

## PAY WHAT YOU LIKE

Many shows operate on a 'Pay What You Like' basis. This means you can get into the show for free and decide afterwards how much you'd like to contribute based on your enjoyment and budget. Watching a show without contributing is also totally okay, but even a tiny contribution goes a long way to support artists!

## PRICED EVENTS

Other shows have a standard ticket price, where tickets can be bought on the website or on the door (although booking in advance guarantees a seat!)
